Dear Parents/Carers

Like schools all around the country, we are becoming increasingly concerned about the effect certain games, videos and internet sites are having upon the behaviour of a small minority of our children.

Our school council recently undertook a survey of children from Year 2 to Year 6. The results were surprising, for example we discovered that in **every** year group at least a quarter of the children had access to material rated 18+!

Obviously we feel that our children at Summerfield are too young to understand what impact this may have on their own behaviour or that of their peers.

With this in mind we are considering offering a 'Keeping Your Child Safe On Line' course run by the Safety Centre, Milton Keynes. This will include information about on line safety and cyber bullying.
