



1pm to 4pm on: 27 November 4 and 11 December



Marlee in Year 3 is fundraising for <u>Little Lady Locks</u> charity and will be cutting off 30cm of hair to help children and young people with hair-loss conditions. Marlee is trying to reach her target of £500 which provides a child with a full lace human hair wig.



"In order for us to make our Children's hair systems, wigs, hats and headbands we require lots and lots of hair donations. Each of our hair systems requires around 300grams of raw hair, this sometimes can be around eight donated pony tails. So as you can imagine we need all the help we can get. That is where our Hair Fairies come into play by spreading the word, cutting and collecting natural hair donations and sending us old hair extensions."


