

I hope you had a brilliant Summer and that you managed to enjoy the sun when it was around!

We have been back in school now for two weeks and I can honestly say it has been an amazing fortnight back. The children are so focused, polite, positive and well-behaved...and the staff have been too! (③

Year 2 have immersed themselves into our topic 'Ocean Adventures.'

They have designed and created underwater dioramas in Art and will be exploring moving mechanisms as part of their DT.
